### Make-up Assignment Guidelines:

1. All make-up projects are due within one week of the missed performance/rehearsal. If no project is turned in, a "0" will be entered for that performance/rehearsal.
2. All make-up projects should be of "publishable" quality, meaning they are good enough to be laminated and displayed in the band room or published on the Band Webpage. Students should be sure that all text is in their own words and is edited for sentence structure, punctuation and spelling. Plagiarism will result in an automatic failure. Please see school website for clearly defined rules and definition of plagiarism.
3. Help with ideas or resources are available from Mrs. Whitlock
4. You will receive full points and no grade penalty for the absence as long as you turn in a quality project by the deadline.

A student missing a rehearsal should complete one of the following projects:

- Create a poster or PowerPoint with pictures and text describing the life & music of a composer of your choice. Some suggestions would be: John Phillip Sousa, John Williams, Eric Whitacre, John Zdechlik, James Curnow, Brian Balmages, Gustav Holst, or other more classical composers.
- Create a poster, 2 page paper, or PowerPoint with pictures and text that describes the event you attended instead of the performance or rehearsal. (only if the event included any type of fine arts activity)
- Record yourself playing all of the music that you missed during the performance. It should be turned in via email or Google Drive. You have one week from the date of the performance to submit the assignment.
- Go to <http://www.theradiohour.net/> and choose one or two of the following drop down menu's
  1. Classical, Jazz, Rock, BMIA, or Guitar
  2. If you are doing make up for a rehearsal, choose one topic from the drop down, study all of its aspects, take the quiz at the end and be sure to PRINT your results.
  3. If you are doing make up for a performance, choose two topics from the drop down menus, study all of their aspects, take both quizzes at the end of each section, and be sure to PRINT your results.

A student missing a Performance should complete one of the following projects: A student missing a performance should complete the following project below AND the Reflection and Self-Assessment

- Record yourself playing all of the music that you missed during the performance. It should be turned in via email or Google Drive. You have one week from the date of the performance to submit the assignment.
